In addition to food, SNAP offers additional benefits for participants. These benefits can be utilized by any household participating in SNAP, even if the household receives the minimum benefit!



Lower electric and gas bills

Lower phone bill (landline or cellphone)

SNAP participants may receive reduced cell phone or landline rates.
