The Food Bank will provide:

- A \$250 stipend per restaurant to cover some of your expenses (check will be issued at the event)
- One 6' table and one 6'x18" classroom table behind you
- A linen for table. Any other fabric you bring must be certified as flame retardant
- Restaurant name banner over table
- · Table sign with menu item listed
- · Trash receptacles
- Hand washing stations
- Listing on the event program given to 1,000 guests
- · Listing with link to your website on Food Bank event website

You are asked to provide:

- 850 2-3 oz. tasting portions of your signature dishes. Please bring hot food hot and cold food cold.
- Disposables for 850 portions (plates, cups, bowls, napkins, flatware, etc.)
- 1-2 servers for your station
- Chafers, fully-enclosed sternos, hot wells or electric burners to heat your food (see restrictions on next page)
- · Coolers and ice, if needed
- · Serving utensils
- Health Department license at your booth
- Promotional items of your choice

Important Dates to Remember

- Friday, January 10, 2025: Participation Agreement Due- Included in this packet
- Friday, February 14, 2025: All Other Paperwork Due- See below
- Friday, March 21, 2025: Last chance to make changes to your menu item

Day of Event (Wednesday, April 2, 2025)

- Please arrive between 3:30-4:30 pm. It is imperative that set up is complete and you are ready to begin serving at 5:30 pm when guests arrive.
- Load-in and load-out may be done through the loading entrance of the WaterFire Arts Center. The Food Bank will provide carts and volunteers to help you load in and find your station. Following load- in, please park your vehicle in the back lot.
- Use of propane, butane, or any other liquid or gas fuel is prohibited inside the WaterFire Arts Center. No open flame is allowed. Sternos must be full enclosed. No deep frying and any oil used in cooking must be contained.
- No overnight storage is available on site after the event. All items must be loaded out after the event. The Food Bank and WaterFire Arts Center are not responsible for items left behind.

Other Requirements

- The RI Health Department may contact you prior to the event to discuss how your food will be handled. They will work with you to ensure that all health codes are being followed. The health department may be in attendance during the event and may inspect your station. Please be prepared with cooling charts and temp logs.
- You will need to provide a Participation Agreement, specially worded COI, Temporary Event
 Mobile Food Service License, a completed W-9 form, and your menu item. Once your
 participation agreement has been received, we will send you a packet with information about
 the wording needed on these forms.
