## About the Food Bank

The Rhode Island Community Food Bank acquires and distributes food through our **147 member agencies**, reaching approximately **84,400 food-insecure Rhode Islanders** each month.

We provide nutritious staples and fresh produce to food pantries, meal sites, shelters, youth programs and senior centers. In FY2024, we distributed **18.3 million pounds of food**.

**81,607 Kids Cafe Meals** served across 4 statewide sites

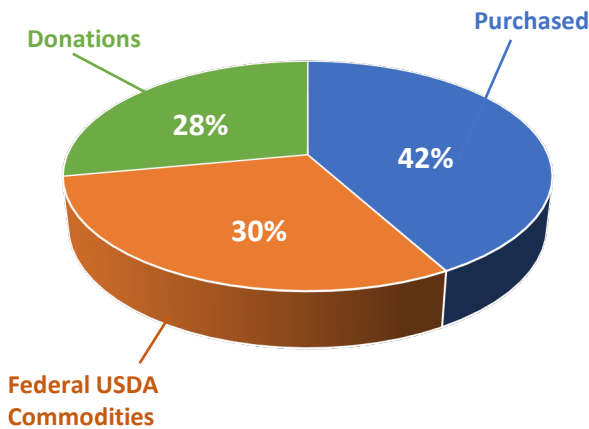

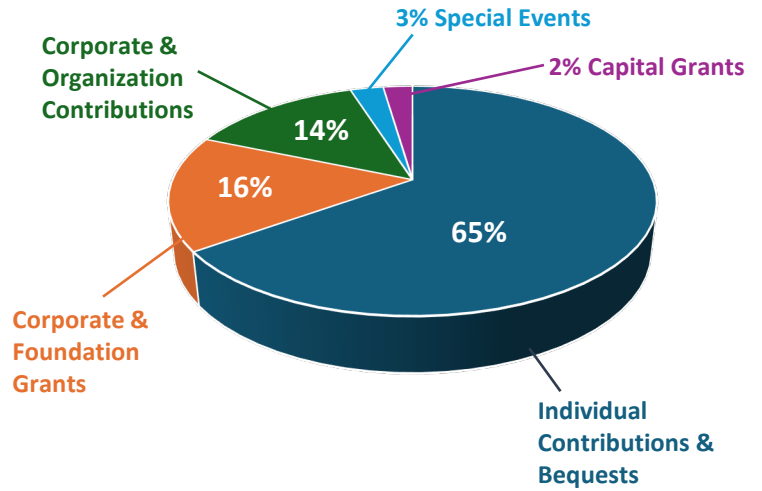
